Page 16: Article IX, Section 1 a: change to read: Past National Presidents shall be invited to attend all National Executive Committee Meetings and National Conventions with a vote and registration fee paid, without compensation, providing they are members in good standing.

PNPs should not have to pay for registration fees to attend meetings.
