<u>IPDP-Honors & Awards</u> Seletha Robertson – N/A During the Higgins Lake Auxiliary weekend, six PDPs held a meeting to discuss the Donor's Rules instructions. They were PDP Allison Aldrich, PDP Maureen Jackson, PDP Kathy Keizer, PDP Peggy Liss, PDP Pat Michalski and PDP Nancy Middleton. The following suggestions were made: #1 Each year the Honors & Awards Chairman will contact the Donor's to verify the written rules are correct. If changes are requested, the H&A Chairman will bring those changes to the Spring SEC for approval. Approved changes will be made to the Donor's Rules and will be included in the March Convention Digest mailing.

## Donor's Rules Requirements:

#1 Past Department Presidents shall have the first option of sponsoring an award when it becomes available (i.e. There is no longer a donor). The award will be for ten (10) years. At the end of the award period, the Donor shall have the option of continuing the award for an additional ten (10) years.

#2 If there is no Past Department President sponsoring an award, a District may be the Donor for a period of 3 years. At the end of the three (3) years, the District may have the option of continuing the award for an additional three (3) years if there are no Past Department Presidents requesting the award.

#3 All awards will be in the name of the Donor (i.e. PDP Kathy Keizer Class A Membership Award). If a donor wishes to honor a deceased PDP, the information will be included under the Award name.

#4 In the case of a death of a Donor, if the award is a plaque, the award will be continued for a maximum of three (3) years or until the plaque is filled – <u>whichever is less</u>.

#5 In the case of a monetary award, if the Donor does not supply the funds for the award, they will forfeit the award. The Department will present a certificate only. The award money will not be the responsibility of the Honors & Awards Chairman nor the Department of Michigan Auxiliary.

#6 Traveling awards or monetary awards will be presented at the Honors & Awards program at the Department Convention. Because there are many Auxiliaries without Post Homes to hang traveling awards, monetary awards may be an option. The Department will prepare a certificate to present with the donation. It is further suggested to limit the amount of the monetary award to a maximum of \$25 each year.

\*\*Motion Kathy Keizer/2<sup>nd</sup> Nancy Middleton to approve the recommendations for the Donor's Rules instructions and requirements. CARRIED

There was a discussion concerning reports. The Secretary suggested when Honors & Awards completes their selection of winners, only the top cover sheet is given to the Secretary to make the awards certificates. Giving the actual reports to the Secretary causes too many questions on how they are judged. Because of these questions, Nancy Middleton is sadly withdrawing her Child Welfare Award. It is now available to another Donor.
