Hopefully by now, your local auxiliary has sent in their Final Service Reports and their donations. These requirements are noted in the Honor & Awards Brochure to be eligible for an award. We all work hard, so be sure your local auxiliary meets the requirements.

Final Service Reports have been reviewed and ready for the Honors & Awards meeting at Convention. Americanism reports totaled: - 12 Auxiliaries reported with 261 projects, 153 volunteers, 2,778 hours and 15,102 miles for a total evaluation of \$90,096.00.
S.O.S. reports totaled: 11 Auxiliaries reported with 126 projects, 67 volunteers, 5,661 hours and 2,329 miles for a total evaluation of \$250,375.00/
