To further express this belief, we are sponsoring a statewide Flag Coloring Contest. We ask your permission to hold such a contest among the students under your jurisdiction. Listed below are the rules of the contest as outlined by our State Department:

- 1. The contest is open to all students in Kindergarten and 1st grade who attend public, private or parochial schools, are home schooled or are involved with Scouting or faith-based groups.
- 2. The Theme is: **Color The American Flag Templat**e. Using the template (or copy of template) provided, students in this age group must color the flag and answer the 4 questions that are included on the template.
- 3. Local entries must be presented to an AMVET or Ladies Auxiliary representative on or before _____
- 4. Department entries must be either hand-delivered with a return receipt from the Ladies Auxiliary Americanism Chairperson by April 1, 2020 or mailed to same and postmarked by April 1, 2020. Entries must have the completed, signed official Department Entry form attached.
- 5. Entries must be on the template provided and may be colored using markers or crayons.
- 6. Entries will be judged on each of the following categories:A. Use of template, or copy, providedB. NeatnessC. Answers to questions
- 7. Each entry <u>must</u> include the full name, birth date, address (including zip code), phone number, and grade of the student. Name, address and phone number of the parent or guardian must also be included. Please remember to indicate the name of the child's teacher and school affiliation.
- 8. Locals and Districts may award prizes with the value to be determined by members.
- 9. The Department shall award the following prizes for Kindergarten and First Grade winning entries: 1^{st} Place - \$50 2^{nd} Place - \$25 3^{rd} Place - \$15

- 1. The contest is open to all students in the 2nd through 5th grades who attend public, private or parochial schools, are home schooled or are involved with Scouting or faith-based groups.
- 2. The Theme is: 'What does freedom mean to me?"
- 3. Local entries must be presented to an AMVET or Ladies Auxiliary representative on or before _____
- 4. Department entries must be either hand-delivered with a return receipt from the Ladies Auxiliary Americanism Chairperson by April 1, 2020 or mailed to same and postmarked by April 1, 2020. Entries must have the completed, signed official Department Entry form attached.
- 5. All entries must address the theme and be free-hand drawings using pen, pencil, crayon, paint or any combination of these media. A straight-edge may be used as an aid to draw a straight line.
- 6. Gluing pictures or other materials to the surface of the drawing is not allowed.
- 7. Entries must be 9" x 12" using construction paper or poster board.
- 8. A written description of the entry, in 50 words or less, must be written on the back of the drawing. Descriptions that are firmly attached to the back of the poster will also be accepted.
- 9. Entries will be judged on each of the following categories:
 a. Artistic Ability
 b. Adherence to Theme
 c. Neatness
- 10. Each entry <u>must</u> include the full name, birth date, address (including zip code), phone number, and grade of the student. Name, address and phone number of the parent or guardian must also be included. Please remember to indicate the name of the child's teacher and school affiliation.
