Beyond raising a puppy or hosting a breeding dog – PAWS has a variety of options. Some current options include:

Puppy Enrichment

While puppies are on campus before they are placed in Foster Puppy Homes - PAWS is providing interactive play and socialization with individual or small groups of puppies.

Dog Enrichment

In the CEC Building, PAWS has people working with our older dogs – in play areas, working on some basic training, working on calming times, baking/creating dog treats, etc.

Drivers

PAWS is looking for people to help with driving. PAWS is always in need of someone to help drive dogs/puppies to its field reps (to place with clients), health clearance appointments (eyes, hearts, etc.), picking up dogs from other organizations PAWS works with, as well as to the SE Michigan area to place with Foster Raisers, etc.

Van Maintenance

People to help keep PAWS vans cleaned (interior/exterior), keep supplied (checking first aid kits, water buckets, seasonal items like ice scrapers)

Fabric and Sewing

People to help create/sew some of the equipment needed for clients – such as door pulls, vests, etc.
